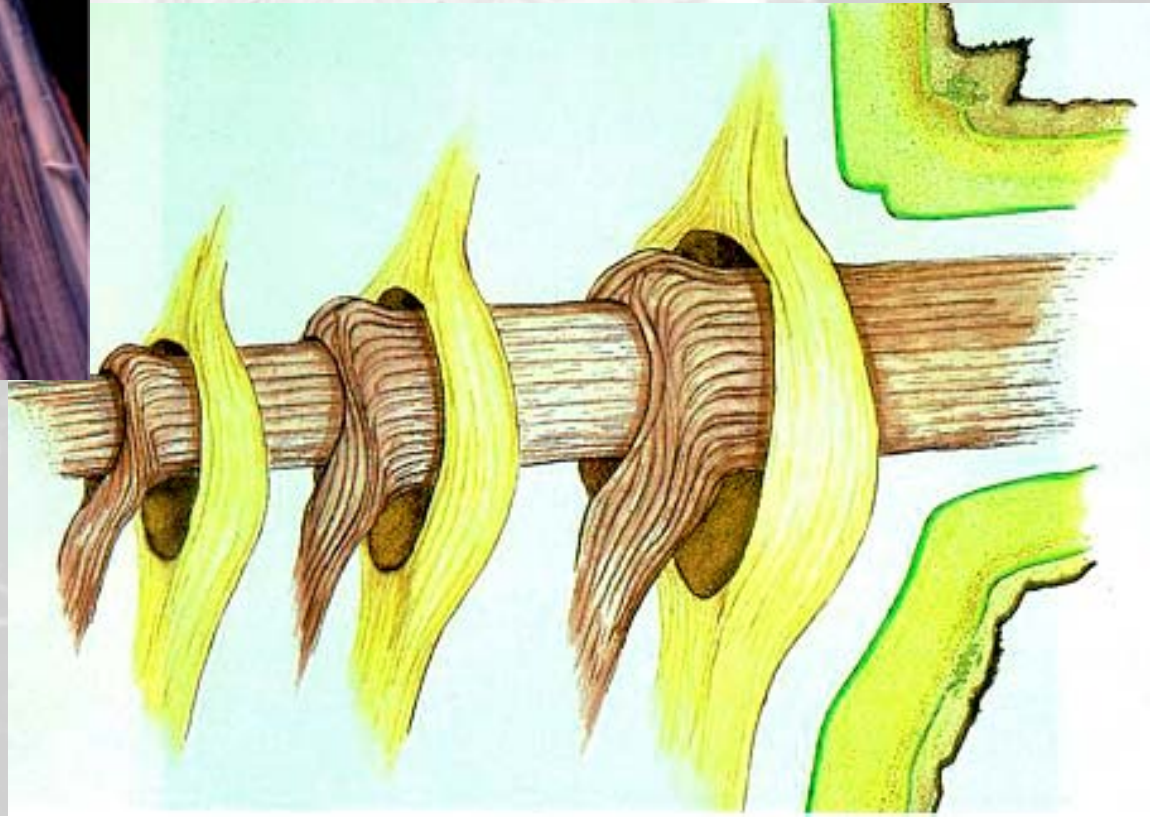

La unión de la rama al tronco



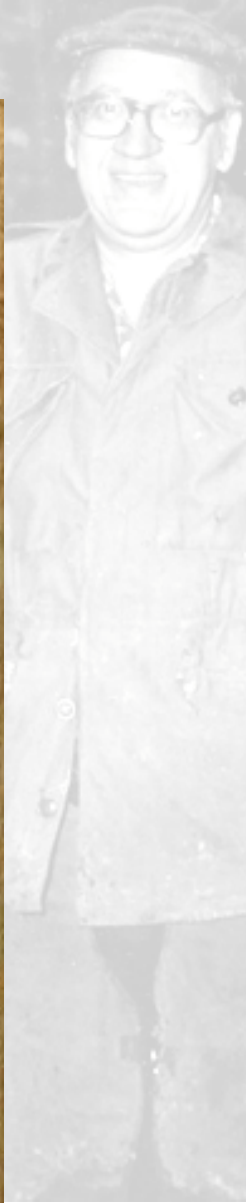
